Crescentia alata fruit for a


multipurpose natural bowl,

The necklace and earring set is made with the core of the *Swietenia*macrophylla fruit (commonly known as big leaf mahogany tree).




Extraordinary flower-like
seeds, from the


Pterospermum suberifolium
